The following agenda points submitted by the Chennai Custom Brokers' Association were taken into cognizance and discussed in brief during the PTFC meeting under the chairmanship of Commissioner.

Point No. 1:

CCBA representative submitted that, last month some changes in system was carried out which allowed for debiting of other port licences at Chennai, when the bill of entry is filed with single licences. For multiple licences still there is no solution other than execution of separate bond

Reply to 1: To this the Commissioner informed that, a letter to DG Systems has already been sent to resolve the above issue and to allow the system to accept multiple licences and bonds for clearance of a particular bill of entry.


Point No. 2:

Regarding licence post export, CCBA representative submitted that for transferable licences, execution of bonds is not required. However, after the changes effected, bills filed with transferable licences could not be cleared without execution of Bond. CCBA requested a solution to this issue at the earliest.

CCBA representative requested that such bills be allowed for release on submitting a simple letter. This letter may be registered as bond and a bond number be issued in EDI. The bills may be cleared using this Bond Number obtained by submitting the letter. The bond number shall be closed once the bill is cleared.

Reply to 2: Commissioner agreed to follow the procedure suggested till the issue is resolved in the system and take up the issue with DG systems immediately.

After the brief discussion on the agenda points, the meeting was concluded by the Chairperson by thanking all the members who were present in the meeting.
