The following agenda points submitted by the Chennai Custom Brokers' Association were taken into cognizance and discussed in brief during the PTFC meeting under the chairmanship of Commissioner

Point No. 1:

When query is raised or first check given on faceless assessment Bills of Entry, even when replied or examination completed, such B/E could not be accessed by the officer for further process, resulting in huge delay in processing the bills.

Reply to 1:

To this Commissioner replied that faceless assessment is a pilot model and the temporary issues faced in the implementation of the model can be rectified by the concerned AC/DC in consultation with the EDI/NIC. The B/Es for which resolution of issue is taking a long time, such B/E may be recalled by Group AC/DC and re-assessed under the normal procedure.

Point No. 2:

Getting reports from Lab is time consuming and existing procedure of sending textile sample to Textile committee has to be restored.

Reply to 2:

It was advised by the Chairman that the CCBA submit a detailed statistical report about the previous and present system of forwarding samples to CRCL with regard to time taken in the process. A study can be done regarding the time taken and the matter can be escalated to Chennai – IV & Chennai – VIII Commissionerates to find a solution to the delay in getting the test reports.


Point No. 3:

After change of CTH from 1st Jan 2020, unable to generate Test Memo with newly added CTH, solution has to be arrived to generate Test Memo.

Reply to 3:

The issue is being taken up with EDI. The temporary solution is to generate manual Test Memo until Test Memo can be generated by system for the particular CTH. It is informed that the EDI have taken up the issue with DG Systems.

The meeting was concluded by the Chairperson by thanking all the members who were present in the meeting.
