4. **Agenda point :**

When Bill of Entry marked to assessment and examination not been prescribed, however the Assessing Officers are overriding it and giving examination orders. It is suggested that such Bill of Entry should not be given examination order.


Reply :

The Commissioner of Customs, Chennai II, replied to the grievance raised by CCBA. He stated that examination order can be given even if RMS has facilitated a Bill of Entry for Examination. Examination order will be given only if there are strong grounds for the same. The CCBA can however on a case to case basis bring of the matter to this Commissionerate where it is felt that examination order overriding RMS has been given. The same will be considered on merits.

5. The CCBA also apologized for accidental inclusion of non-stakeholder in the PTFC meeting, and said they were not aware of the presence of that individual. The Commissioner made it clear that non-stakeholder cannot attend the meeting without a specific invite.
