Subject – ICES Advisory:13/2022 dated 23.09.2022 - Capturing additional details for Certificate of Origin (COO) as per Customs (Administration of Rules of Origin under Trade Agreements) Rules, 2020 in Bill of Entry – Reg.

Kind attention of Importers/Customs Brokers and the trade is invited to the Board's Notification 81/2020 - Customs (N.T.) dated 21.08.2020 on the subject Regulations and Advisory No. 34/2020 dated 17.09.2020 and corresponding Facility Circular 045/2020 issued by this office where in it is informed to mention additional information with respect to import under Free/Preferential Trade Agreements.

2. As per the instructions from Board, certain additional declarations will be captured for the import declaration (Bills of Entry) with respect to import under Free/Preferential Trade Agreements. Accordingly, the additional declarations will be sought in the Bill of Entry while claiming PTA/FTA notifications at item level in the Bill of Entry under the BE_ITEM_SW_INFO_TYPE table. The details of the same are attached as **Annexure I** to this Advisory. These changes will be effective for Bills of Entry filed w.e.f. 3rd October 2022.
