NOTICE INVITING e-TENDER FOR "REVAMPING OF EDI SECTION, PHASE - 3" FOR OFFICE OF THE PRINCIPAL COMMISSIONER OF CUSTOMS, GENERAL COMMISSIONERATE, CUSTOM HOUSE, CHENNAI - 600 001.

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The Customs Department under Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs, is inviting e-Tender/Bids from reputed Firms/Companies, for "Revamping of EDI section -Phase - 3" at Custom House, No.60, Rajaji Salai, Chennai - 600 001.

#### I. **Document Download:**

The bidders having Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) issued from any agency authorized by Controller of Certifying Authority (CCA), Govt. of India, can download the tender documents including Annexure-A, Annexure-B & Annexure-C from CPPP website https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app or www.chennaicustoms.gov.in or www.cbic.gov.in and submit the bids as per the schedule given below:

#### II. Bid Submission:

- 1. Bids shall be submitted online only **CPPP** website: https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app.
- Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white option which (b) helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- Not more than one tender shall be submitted by one contractor or contractors having business relationship. Under no circumstances father and his son(s) or other close relations who have business relationship with one another (i.e. when one or more partner(s)/director(s) are common) will be allowed to submit tender for the same contract as separate competitors. A breach of this condition will render the tenders of both parties liable to rejection.

- 3. Bidders who have downloaded the tender from the Central Public Procurement Portal (CPPP) website <a href="https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app">https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</a> shall not tamper/modify the tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case if the same is found to be tampered/modified in any manner, tender will be completely rejected and EMD would be forfeited and bidder is liable to be banned from doing business with this Office.
- 4. Intending bidders are advised to visit CPPP website <a href="https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app">https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</a> regularly till closing date of submission of tender, for any corrigendum / addendum/ amendment.
- The rates shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.
- 6. The rates will be **inclusive of all taxes** (**excluding GST**), fees, levies, etc., and any revision in the statutory taxes, fees, etc., will be the responsibility of the Bidder.
- In case of any discrepancy/difference in the amounts indicated in figures and words, the amount in words will prevail and will be considered.
- 8. The quoted rates shall remain firm throughout the tenure of the contract and no revision is permissible for any reason.
- **NOTE**: The competent authority of General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai reserves the right to postpone the date of opening of the Tender or to accept or to reject any or all the bids/ quotations, without assigning any reason.

### III. TENDER DOCUMENTS

- 1. Tender Process and uploading of Tender documents:
- a) The tender/bid will consist of two parts Technical Bid (ANNEXURE-A) and Financial Bid (ANNEXURE-B). The bid of all parties whose rates quoted by them, finds mention in their Technical Bid, shall be rejected forthwith. All information sought under terms and conditions and other information are to be given in Technical Bid while the price quoted by them shall be mentioned only in the Financial Bid.
- b) The tender/bids received incomplete and/or filed after the due date and time, shall be summarily rejected.
- c) The Financial Bids of only those companies/firms/parties shall be opened whose Technical Bids are found to be eligible.
- d) The Department reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason. In case of any dispute of any kind and in respect of whatsoever, the decision of the Competent Authority, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai 600 001, will be final and binding.
- 2. **Authenticity of the tender document**: Every page of tender document including enclosures must be duly signed with date and company seal by the bidder.
- 3. **Tender Document**: The tender documents containing terms and conditions along with prescribed proforma/format for furnishing required information/details can be downloaded from the portal <a href="https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app">https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app</a>, <a href="https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app">www.chennaicustoms.gov.in</a> and <a href="https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app">www.chennaicustoms.gov.in/eprocure/app</a>,
- 4. Earnest Money Deposit [EMD] and Performance Security / Bank Guarantee:
- a) Tender documents must be accompanied with non-interest bearing Earnest Money of Rs. 90,000/- (Rupees Ninty Thousand only) in the form of Demand Draft in favour of

the "Commissioner of Customs, Chennai", payable at Chennai, failing which tender will be summarily rejected.

- b) Cheques will not be accepted.
- c) Original Demand Draft of EMD should be submitted at CHS Unit, Custom House, No.60, Rajaji Salai, Chennai - 600 001 on or before due date. No earnest money deposit will be accepted after the due date and time of submission of tender document.
- d) Earnest money deposited for other Tenders will not be adjustable with this Tender.
- e) No bank commission or interest will be paid on the earnest money deposit.
- f) If a bidder withdraws their bid before opening of the tender or after awarding the contract then their earnest money deposited (EMD) will be forfeited and liable to be banned from doing business with this Office.
- g) If a successful bidder fails to deposit requisite amount towards the Performance Security within specified time the earnest money deposited will be forfeited and will be barred from contesting the Tender for a period of 12 months.
- h) Central/State Government and Central/State Government Undertakings, firms registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Ministry of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) are exempted from deposit of Earnest Money.
- i) The successful bidder of the Contract has to submit a Performance Security / Bank Guarantee of 3% of the Total Value of the Contract either by way of Fixed Deposit or Bank Guarantee within seven days from the date of awarding the contract which is non-interest bearing in the form of Fixed Deposit / Bank Guarantee issued by a Scheduled / Nationalised Bank drawn in favour of the "Commissioner of Customs, Chennai", payable at Chennai. Performance Security / Fixed Deposit receipts (certificate in original) should remain valid for a period of 90 days beyond the date of completion of all contractual obligations of the service provider with auto renewal clause.

#### IV. Refund of Earnest Money Deposit & Performance Security:

- a) Earnest money deposited by the unsuccessful bidder will be refunded to the bidder at the earliest after finalization of the tender. Earnest money deposit of the successful bidder shall be returned on submission of Performance Security @ 3 % of the total contract value.
- b) The Performance Security will be forfeited in case of unsatisfactory performance of the successful bidder. The decision of the Competent Authority, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai 600 001, on this account, will be final and binding on successful bidder.

#### V. Rates:

- a) Rate/bid/offer must be without any condition, assumption, qualification, reservation or variation. *Rate/bid/offer* must be mentioned in prescribed Proforma in figures and in words in respect of each item separately. In case of any discrepancy, rates quoted in words will prevail. Conditional tender offer or offer at variance from prescribed specification would be ineligible to compete for the tender. Prices and price components shall be firm and shall not be subject to any price variation or adjustment on account of any price escalations throughout the execution of the contract.
- b) The bidder shall quote their rate inclusive of all taxes (excluding GST).

- c) The rates inclusive of all taxes (excluding GST), fees, levies, etc., and any revision in the statutory taxes, fees, etc. have to be shown separately in the financial bid (Annexure B) i.e. in BOQ Excel sheet.
- VI. <u>Subletting of Contract:</u> The successful bidder shall not be allowed to sublet/subcontract the contract to any other contractor.

#### VII. Completion Period:

- a) Contract has to be completed within a period of **30 days** from the date of issue of Work Order.
- b) Liquidated damage (LD) will be charged @ of 2.50% per completed work or part thereof for delay subject to maximum of 10% of the value of work order.

#### VIII. Prescribed format /Proforma:

- a) Annexure A (Technical Bid), Annexure B (Financial Bid) BOQ are to be duly filled by the bidder in respect of each item.
- b) A self attested declaration i.e. Annexure C regarding non-blacklisting or non-convicting by any court of law is to be duly submitted.

#### IX. Documents required to be uploaded along with technical bid:

- a) A Copy of Terms & Conditions duly signed with date along with company seal, in all the pages by the Bidder, non-compliance will liable for rejection.
- b) **Demand Draft** in favour of the **"Commissioner of the Customs"**, payable at Chennai, as Earnest Money Deposit.
- c) GST Registration Certificate and Income Tax (PAN) card.
- d) All other supporting documents as required in the tender shall be attached.
- e) Signed declaration as given in Annexure C of the bid document.
- f) Two Experience certificates containing details of similar contracts handled/executed by the tendering company/firm/agency for Government Departments of Central/State, costing not less than Rs. **25 Lakhs** in each case.
- g) Income Tax Returns for the last three Assessment years i.e. A.Y 2019-20, A.Y. 2020-21 & A.Y. 2021-22 should also be uploaded.
- h) Copies of GST filed for the last three months ending 31.08.2022.
- i) Average Annual Turnover for the last three years ending 31.03.2021 with last 03 ITRs, from a Chartered Accountant.
- j) The Bidder should have minimum ten years of experience in similar type of works with any organisations of the Central/State Government. Copy of the documents to be enclosed.

#### X. Eligibility criteria for bidder:

a) Only those Firms/Companies/Agencies will be eligible to tender their bids whose annual turnover is at least Rs. *1 Crore* or above in each of the last three financial years ending 31.03.2021.

- b) Only those firms who have successfully completed two similar works (means works similar to those mentioned in BOQ) costing not less than Rs.**25** *Lakhs* each in any Government Departments (Central/State) during last 3 years, ending 31.03.2022.
- c) The authorized dealer / franchise / distributor may submit bids on behalf of the firms/Company/Manufacturer along with valid authorization letter issued by the firms/Company/Manufacturers to the bidder for this particular tender, to do so subjected to Conditions **X** (a) & **X**(b) as mentioned above. Preference would be given to manufacturers registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC), Ministry of Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME). [Supporting documents to be attached].
- d) The firms/companies/manufacturers should have minimum 10 years of experience in this field.
- **XI.** Validity of the offer / bid: The offer/bid of the bidder should be valid for at least for 6 months from the date of opening of Technical bid.
- XII. Scope of Work: The work is to be carried out as per plan:

Civil works - Supply and fixing of 40mm thick Wooden False, painting, wooden wall panelling etc. i.e., Specifications are provided in the Annexure-B/Bill of Quantity.

#### XIII. Terms and conditions:

- a. Minimum warranty period for the materials used for the said work would be one year and the same will be effective from the date of handing over to the Department.
- b. The Department has the right to change the quantity and specifications of the items in the work order as per actual requirement, which may vary depending upon various factors.
- c. The Competent Authority, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai 600 001, may without prejudice, for breach of any of the terms and conditions of the tender, 10 days after issuing a written notice of default, terminate this contract in whole or in parts:
  - i. If he fails to execute the work in full within the time period(s) specified in the tender or any extension thereof granted by the Competent Authority, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai-1.
  - ii. If he fails to perform any other instructions or,
  - iii. If he, in either of the above circumstances, does not rectify his failure within a period of 30 days or longer period as specified by the office of Principal Commissioner of Customs, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai 600001, after receipt of default notice from the office of the Principal Commissioner of Customs, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai.
- (d) The tendering firm is advised to visit the site of work i.e. **Ground Floor, Ganga Block, Custom House, No.60, Rajaji Salai, Chennai 600 001,** with prior appointment at his own cost for examination and collect all information that he considers necessary for proper assessment of the prospective assignment. The Quantity prescribed in BOQ is final. Any deviations in bidder's assessment and BOQ, if observed, shall be intimated to the Department prior to bid closing date. A bidder shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he

inspects it or not and no extra charge consequent to any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed.

- (e) The work will consist of labour, all the essential ingredients like sand, cement, tiles, Bricks, distemper, oil paints, pipes, taps, electrical fixtures, electrical wires etc from reputed companies and other building materials which will be supplied and expenses/charges of which to be borne by the contractor/bidder.
- (f) The Contractor/Bidder shall be responsible for arranging and maintaining at his own cost all materials, tools, water, electricity access, facilities for workers and all other services required for executing the work unless otherwise specifically provided for in the contract documents. Online submission of a tender implies that the bidder has read notice and all other contract documents and has made himself/herself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and local condition and rates and other factors having a bearing on the execution of the work. Cost of site visit shall be borne by the bidder.
- (g) All labour Employed by the Contractor shall be covered by the Workman's Compensation Act. Any death, injury or mishap to the workmen of the Contractor will entirely be the Contractor's responsibility and the Competent Authority, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai 600001, shall not be liable to pay any damages for the same.
- (h) The personnel deployed for execution of works should be well experienced and trained adequately and of sound health. They should be provided with proper equipment and safety gear. While carrying out the work, extreme care should be taken to ensure the safety of the people engaged by the contractor for the work.
- (i) Contractor shall take adequate/mandatory safety precautions to avoid any accident etc. at site and shall be fully responsible for any criminal & civil liabilities. All safety arrangements are to be made by contractor at his own cost.
- (j) If the Contractor/firm fails to perform his functions stipulated in this contract properly to the satisfaction of the Department or any loss, damage, pilferage, theft etc. occurs in the premises or for any of the losses or damages either liquidated or unliquidated, the Department can initiate proceedings against the Contractor for the recovery of damages / losses and the Department can, in addition to all such remedies, forfeit the performance guarantee. On the question whether loss or damage is caused or not, the decision of the Department shall be final. Security deposit or balance of performance guarantee after recoveries shall be returned within three months after termination / cancellation / end of contract.
- (k) The contractor shall take all possible precautions to prevent any unlawful/disorderly conduct or acts of the workers deployed. The Contractor shall be fully responsible for theft, burglary, fire and any mischievous deeds by his staff/workers and other persons. The Persons/workers so employed should be engaged by the Contractor and shall remain under his direct control and supervision. He shall be liable for the wages and any other claim of the person so engaged.
- (l) Bidder should not indulge in employing child labour or any other malpractices in violation of labour laws or any other laws applicable to the services provided by the bidder.

- (m) The Contractor shall be solely responsible for any/all disputes between him and the personnel deployed by him. The Department will not entertain any such dispute and there should be no claim or liability against Chennai Customs Authority or any of its officers on this account. The Contractor will keep the Competent Authority, General Commissionerate, Custom House, Chennai indemnified against all actions.
- (n) All existing statutory regulations (both the State & the Central Governments) shall beadhered to and complied with by the Contractor.
- (o) **Liquidated Damages:** In the event of the Contractor's failure to complete the work within the stipulated time of this bid document, the COMPETENT AUTHORITY may also deduct 1% of total contract value for delaying of work completion per day from the L-1 Bidder as liquidated damages, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 15% of the value of the contract.
- (p) The price quoted by the contractor will be final and No escalation of price whatsoever would be allowed.
- (q) This office reserves the right to terminate the services of the Contractor at any time without giving any notice whatsoever.
- (r) Any dispute arising out of this agreement or that which may arise in future, shall be resolved by taking recourse to mutual settlement, arbitration / conciliation of THE ARBITRATION AND CONCILITION ACT, 1996 and is subjected to Chennai Jurisdiction only.
- (s) The Contractor shall clear' the site in all respects and remove all materials after completion of work.
- (t) The department shall also not be responsible or liable for any theft, loss, damage or destructions of any property of the contractor lying in the premises by their employees from any cause whatsoever.
- (u) Any delay due to reasons beyond control of the contractor, this office may grant suitable time extension for which the contractor has to request along with the justification/ reasons well in advance to the competent authority for approval without any prejudice to price escalation. The decision of the competent authority regarding Time extension will be final and binding on the contractor.
- (v) Due to restriction of driving slow moving vehicle / hand driven rickshaw in MCD areas, it is required that contractor should not operate the hand driven rickshaw. Contractor has to make his own arrangement of desired transportation & nothing extra shall be payable on this account.
- (w) Any damage done to the existing structure shall be made good by the contractor at his own risk and cost.
- (x) The contractor shall be responsible for behaviour and conduct of his worker. No worker with doubtful integrity or having a bad record shall be engaged by the contractor
- (y) No dismantled material should be thrown out from ground or upper floors of the building. All the dismantled material should be carried out to ground through Chute made of PVC pipe of suitable size & proper clamped only at no extra cost.

- (z) The payment will be made through NEFT/RTGS/ECS only after the completion of the work and submission of bill along with Completion Certificate provided that there is no dispute in respect of rates, quantity and quality of work. Tax shall be deducted at source as per the prevailing Income Tax Act, 1961 and GST Acts, 2017 horn the bill and **no advance payment will be made against this contract.**
- (aa) The quoted rates shall remain firm throughout the tenure of the contract and no revision is permissible for any reason.
- (bb) It is mandatory that all the supporting and related documents including the Departmental Tender Documents shall be duly signed by the Authorised Signatory & affix the company/firm seal and to be uploaded in Technical Bid Cover I, failing which the bid/tender shall be summarily rejected.

# XIV. SPECIAL CONDITIONS AS PER NATIONAL GREEN TRIBUNAL (NGT) GUIDELINES:

- (a) No government, authority, contractor, builders or any person would be permitted to store/dump construction material or debris on metalled road.
- (b) Beyond the metalled road the area where such the construction material or debris can be stored shall be physically demarcated by officers of all the concerned Authorities/Corporation ensuring that it would not cause any obstruction to the free flow of traffic/inconvenience to the pedestrians. It should be ensured that no accidents occur on account of such permissible storage.
- (c) Every builder, contractor or person shall ensure that the construction material is covered by tarpaulin and all other precaution should be taken to ensure that no dust particles are permitted to pollute air quality as a result of such storage. It shall also be ensured that appropriate protection measures are taken by raising wind breakers of appropriate height on all sides of the plot/area using plastic and/or other similar material to ensure that no construction material dust fly outside the plot are and it will be the builder/contractor responsibility to ensure that their activity does not cause any air pollution during course of construction and/ or storage of material or construction activity. This condition shall be strictly adhered to by every builder, contractor, person or authority. In the event of default, they shall be liable to be prosecuted under the law in force, as well as for causing environmental pollution and will be liable to pay compensation which would be determined by Tribunal in accordance with law.
- (d) All the trucks or vehicles of any kind which are used for construction purposes/ are carrying construction material like cement, sand and other allied material should be fully covered. The vehicles should be properly cleaned should be dust free and every necessary precautions is to be taken to ensure that en route their destination, the dust, sand or any other particles are not permitted to be released in air/contaminate air.
- (e) The Bidder/Contractors should strictly compliance with Hon'ble National Green Tribunal in order dated 10.14.2015 has directed as follows:
- (f) Every builder or owner shall put tarpaulin on scaffolding around the area of construction and the building. No person including builder, owner can be permitted to store any construction material particularly sand on any part of the street, roads in any colony.
- (g) The construction material of any kind that is stored in the site will be fully covered in all respects so that it does not disperse in the Air in any form.

- (h) All the construction material and debris shall be carried in the trucks or other vehicles which are fully covered and protected so as to ensure that the construction debris or the construction material does not get dispersed into the air or atmosphere, in any form whatsoever.
- (i) The dust emissions from the constructions site should be completely controlled and all precautions taken in that behalf.
- (j) The vehicles carrying construction material and construction debris of any kind should be cleaned before it is permitted to ply on the road after unloading of such material.
- (k) Every worker working on the construction site and involved in loading, unloading and carriage of construction material and construction debris shall be provided with mask to prevent inhalation of dust particles.
- (l) Every owner and or builder shall be under obligation to provide all medical help, investigation and treatment to the workers involved in the construction of building and carry of construction material and debris relatable to dust emissions.
- (m) It shall be the responsibility of every builder to transport constructions material and debris waste to construction site, dumping site or any other place in accordance with rules and terms of this order.
- (n) All to take appropriate measures and to ensure that the terms and conditions of the earlier order and these orders should strictly comply with by fixing sprinklers, creations of green air barriers.
- (o) Compulsory use of wet jet in grinding and stone cutting.
- (p) Wind breaking wall around construction site.

#### XV. Payments:

- a. No advance payment will be made for any of the works stated above.
- b. The amount quoted by successful bidder is final and no additional payment shall be made.
