4. Shri Rajesh V Shelke, Addl. Commissioner (CCO) welcomed all and stated that Weekly CCFC meeting is being conducted as mandated by the Board and the agenda for this Meeting shall revolve around the prevailing global situation due to the ongoing Gulf crisis. The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) informed that Commissioner (General) would chair the Meeting and requested Shri Prasad Adelli, Commissioner (General) to Chair the Meeting and deliver the opening remarks. The Chairman welcomed the participants and asked the Addl. Commissioner (CCO) to continue the proceedings.

5. The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) stated that in the last Weekly CCFC Meeting, points in writing were not submitted by any Member and for today's Meeting, CCBA raised four points which do not relate to the issues emanating out of Gulf Crisis and requested the Chairman to elaborate for the benefit of

all.

5.1 The Chairman stated that the idea of holding Weekly CCFC Meeting was conceived with a specific aim of sorting out the issues arising out of Gulf Crisis on an urgent basis and only those issues related to the Gulf Crisis shall be discussed in today's Meeting. The Chairman further stated that the points raised by CCBA for discussion today are outside the ambit of Weekly CCFC Meeting. The Chairman informed the Members that issues relating to systems may be submitted directly to the General Commissionerate without waiting for them to be raised in the PTFC and CCFC Meetings and the same shall be taken up with the Directorate of Systems.

5.2 The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) informed Shri R.N.Sekar, Secretary, CCBA, that the four points raised by CCBA (issues unrelated to Gulf Crisis) for discussion today, have to be initially raised in the PTFC Meetings which are being held fortnightly by the Commissionerates and asked him to raise them in the PTFC Meetings, if not already done.

(Action: Secretary, CCBA)

5.3 The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) asked the Members to raise the points (other than those related to Gulf Crisis) in the PTFC Meetings first and as per escalation matrix, only those points which remain unresolved in the PTFC Meetings, shall be taken up in the regular CCFC Meeting which will be held virtually in the last week of this month.

(Action: All the Members of CCFC)

6. The Chairman invited the participants to raise points, if any, related to the Gulf Crisis. As none of the participants raised any points, the Chairman concluded the Meeting by thanking all the Members.

7. The Meeting ended with thanks to the Chair.
