4. Shri Rajesh V Shelke, Addl. Commissioner (CCO) welcomed all and stated that Weekly CCFC meeting is being conducted as mandated by the Board and the agenda for this Meeting shall revolve around the prevailing global situation due to the ongoing Gulf crisis. The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) informed that Commissioner (ACC) would chair the Meeting and requested Dr. Manjula D Hosmani, Commissioner (ACC) to Chair the Meeting and deliver the opening remarks. The Chairperson welcomed the participants and asked the Addl. Commissioner (CCO) to continue the proceedings.

5. The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) informed that for today's Weekly CCFC Meeting, no points were sponsored by any Member. The Chairperson stated that since no points related to Gulf crisis were sponsored in the last three Weekly CCFC Meetings, if Members agree, we may return to conducting regular CCFC Meetings once in two months as mandated by the Board vide

Circular No. 21/2025-Customs dated 12.09.2025. Shri R.N.Sekar, Secretary, CCBA, also seconded by saying that issues related to Gulf crisis have been resolved one by one and there may not be any points for discussion in the Weekly CCFC Meetings.

6. The Addl. Commissioner (CCO) reiterated once again in today's Meeting also by requesting the Members to raise the points in the PTFC Meetings first which are being held fortnightly by the Commissionerates and as per escalation matrix, only those points which remain unresolved in the PTFC Meetings, shall be taken up in the regular CCFC Meeting which will be held virtually on 05.06.2026 at 12.00 Noon. The ADC (CCO) further stated that while mailing the points for discussion in the regular CCFC Meeting, it must be clearly mentioned that the point had already been raised in the PTFC Meeting but remain unresolved.
